

Bloomsbury Street Day Nursery Fee Sheet

Fees effective from 1st April 2026:

Our opening hours are 8:00am to 6:00pm, Monday to Friday, and the nursery operates for 50 weeks each year. We also offer early starts from 7:30am, and late finishes until 6:30pm.

Our fees are calculated to take this into account, and reflect a full year divided by twelve, so you will pay the same amount each month. The nursery fees are reviewed each year in line with changes to operational costs.

Please note that the 'Over 3 Years Old' fees will be applied in the month following a child's third birthday.

A place at our nursery is subject to payment of our non-refundable registration fee of £50. A £200 deposit is also required upon acceptance of your child's place.

The registration fee and deposit are not required for children accessing their funded entitlement only. In all other cases, the deposit is refundable and returned to you when the required notice is given for your child to leave the nursery. Please see our Parent Terms and Conditions for further information.

Funded hours are provided at no charge. The 'Funded Fee' columns reflect the cost of additional hours and voluntary extras for each booking pattern. Government funding only covers the cost of the provision of childcare and the delivery of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). The funding does not include any of the other services that our nurseries provide, which include, but are not limited to:

- Enrichment activities such as Forest School, Beach School, Debutots, Hartbeeps and Music with Mike
- Meals and snacks
- Nursery supplies, including educational materials above and beyond the EYFS.

*All charges for the above are voluntary for children accessing funded hours. Parents may opt out of any or all.

The fees above show the amount you would pay for your child's place if taking a combination of funded hours, voluntary extras, and sessions that are not covered by the Government funding.

Our voluntary extras are calculated as follows:

- Meals and Snacks - £10/£12 per day (School day/Full day)

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- Hygiene Consumables - £6 per day
 - Extracurricular Activities and Trips - £20 per day
 - Other Educational Activities above EYFS - £6 per day

Extra Nursery Sessions:

Parents wishing their children to attend a 'one-off' extra session will be charged at the rates shown above. Unfortunately, we are unable to offer a refund should you subsequently cancel the session.

Payment Information:

We request that all nursery fees are paid before the start of the invoiced period. Payment details and the amounts you will need to pay will be sent to you in an invoice through our parent app, as well as information on late payment charges should we need to apply them.

Tax-Free Childcare:

Tax-Free Childcare is a Government service to help working parents with the cost of their childcare. For every £8 a parent pays into their childcare account, the Government will pay an extra £2, up to a maximum of £2,000 every year for each child.
